July 30

Depart Meijer for Indianola, IA at 7 a.m. Stop for lunch on your own and shopping at the Czech Village/New Bohemia Marketplace in Cedar Rapids, IA. Depart Cedar Rapids for Norwalk, IA to check into the Fairfield Inn & Suites before departing to National Balloon Classic for evening viewing and dinner on your own.

July 31

Enjoy a Continental breakfast at the hotel before departing for our very busy day! Tour the flower and herb gardens of Rose Farms. Then, we head to Indianola to learn about the History of Flight at the National Balloon Museum. We will hit a high note with lunch and a special performance at the world-renown Des Moines Metro Opera. After lunch and a few arias, honey tasting from the owner of Milk and Honey who trained in Bologna, Italy. We'll have time to explore the shops in downtown Indianola with a free ice cream cone at The Corner Sundry an old-fashioned soda fountain that has stood for over 70 years. Before we depart for the Balloon Classic, we will enjoy a beer and wine flight with light bites at West Hill Brewery. VIP Sky Suite for balloon viewing and Night Glows drone show.

August 1

It's an early morning for Balloons, Bellinis and Breakfast at the National Balloon Classic. We head to Amana Colonies in Cedar Rapids. The history of Amana Colonies, a National Historic Landmark and one of America's longest-lived communal societies, begins in 1714 in the villages of Germany and continues today on the Iowa prairie. Enjoy the unique history, shops and restaurants with lunch on your own. Return to Meijer around 7 p.m.
